Information, Rules, and Regulations

Booth Space

Each artist/crafter will be provided a 10 x 10 booth space. The artist/crafter provides tent, signage, tables, etc. No sky signs, please. No electricity is available. We cannot guarantee booth space or location of booth within Arts & Craft Village.

Handmade Arts & Crafts

Quality handmade crafts and artwork only. Please send a photograph of your booth and your merchandise with your application. Only items listed on application will be allowed to be displayed or sold. If the committee deems your merchandise not suitable for our event, your check will be returned. The Pacific BeachFest Committee reserves the right to determine those businesses, organizations or activities most suitable for this event.

- No material unsuitable for family viewing
- No merchandise with the words "Pacific BeachFest"
- No food or drinks for sale
- No commercially produced items, e.g. Beanie Babies
- No balloons for sale
- No sale of alcohol or tobacco products

Vendors offering such merchandise for sale will be removed from the event immediately.

Booth Set-up

Staggered 7 a.m. - 9 a.m. You will be assigned in advance exact check-in and unload time. Artists/crafters must check-in at the Artist/Crafter Headquarters booth located at Garnet Ave. & Mission Blvd. All artists/crafters must have their vehicles off the street by 10 a.m. *Absolutely no vehicles on the street during Pacific BeachFest.*

Booth Breakdown and Clean-up

After 6 p.m. No early departures. Clean-up of the booth area is the responsibility of the vendor. Booth space must be cleaned immediately after closing.

Booth Decoration

The Pacific BeachFest Committee asks that all vendors use tables, sandwich boards, easels, etc. to display all goods for sale. Signage, and decorations of booth are encouraged as

long as it is in good taste and doesn't interfere with neighboring vendors. The committee reserves the right to remove any décor deemed inappropriate for the event.

Seller's Permit Number

The State Board of Equalization requires that all vendors provide a California Seller's Permit Number. A temporary or regular permit is free. Vendors simply complete an application.
